• The Hardest Fight Comes After Mosul Falls

After eight months of grinding conflict, Iraqi commanders are now confident that the battle to retake Mosul from ISIS is in its final phase. Pushing across the Tigris River, Iraqi Security Forces have liberated nearly all of western Mosul and, although defeating ISIS' last stand in the densely packed urban environment of the Old City will be difficult, Iraq's generals predict victory as early as June 10. As Lieutenant General Qasim Nazzal told Iraqi state television on Sunday that ISIS "is drawing its last dying breath."

After sheltering in Turkey from the ongoing war, some Syrian refugees are willing to go back despite the security risks to observe the holy month of Ramadan with the loved ones they left behind. The Cilvegözü border crossing in Turkey's Hatay province, a main crossing into Syria, which shares a lengthy border with Turkey, opened to crossings into the war-torn country yesterday. About 1,000 people returned to the country to spend a month and to observe Ramazan Bayramı, also known as Eid al-Fitr, the festival at the end of the sacred month. The local governorate has allowed crossings for Syrians until June 23, and returnees will be allowed back in starting July 3.
