After they seized Mosul two years ago and destroyed the priceless Mesopotamian artifacts in its museum, Islamic State militants found a practical use for the building - they turned it into a tax office. The outside world learned of the museum's initial fate from a video Islamic State released months later showing its fighters smashing Assyrian, Akkadian, Babylonian, Persian and Roman artifacts, many of them two millennia old or older.

In October 2016, the Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) strategists and commanders were fully aware of the sheer number of Iraqi armed forces that were moving in to encircle Mosul. The operation to retake Iraq's second-largest city was officially launched last October, and in January its eastern half was declared "fully liberated". Mosul is ISIL's last major urban stronghold in Iraq.

Daesh suicide bombers kill 31 in Iraq

Militants opened fire and later blew themselves up in the Iraqi city of Tikrit, killing at least 31 people in an attack claimed Wednesday by Daesh. Police and army officers said the attack, which began on Tuesday night, also wounded at least 42 people. A police lieutenant colonel said three militants shot dead three policemen in central Tikrit and then opened fire on civilians, before later blowing themselves up inside homes in the area.

Number of foreign jihadists in Iraq and Syria unknown: US

US intelligence agencies don't know the true number of foreign jihadists still fighting in Iraq and Syria, or the extent of the threat they pose to their home countries, a senior US military officer said Wednesday. Some 40,000 foreign jihadists have joined the Islamic State group in Iraq and Syria from at least 120 countries in Europe, Africa and southeast Asia, General Michael Nagata said at Washington's Center for Strategic and International Studies think-tank.

Kurdistan still separate from Iraq 26 years after No-Fly Zone was established

Twenty-six years after the United Nations Security Council adopted Resolution 688, the United States in cooperation with the United Kingdom and France launched Operation Provide Comfort that established the No-Fly Zone over the 36th parallel and shielded much of what is now the Kurdistan Region from aerial strikes by the Iraqi air force. "This is [in Kurdistan] what we wanted to happen in Iraq," said US Ret. Lt. Gen. Jay Garner in the Kurdistan Region in December 2016.

Half century needed to clear mines in Iraq, Syria: UN

"We are looking at decades of work for these countries to look like post-World War II Europe where we still find some unexploded ordnance here and there," said Agnes Marcaillou, director of the United Nations Mine Action Service, addressing a news conference to mark International Mine Awareness Day. She said her office, which also deals with IEDs and unexploded ordnance, is looking at a "ballpark figure" of between \$170 million to \$180 million a year to clean up the areas retaken from the ISIS terrorist group in Iraq.
