# Over 40% of IS-Controlled Mosul Retaken, Iraq Says

Iraqi forces have retaken more than 40% of Islamic State-controlled Mosul as part of an ongoing campaign to drive the militant organization from its last key stronghold in the country, a senior commander said on Sunday. Lieutenant-General Talib Shaghati, the chief of the elite anti-terrorism service, said that 40 to 50% of western Mosul has been "liberated" less than a month after Iraq started a US-backed offensive against Islamic State there.

# Troops Move Further into Mosul; 74 Killed in Iraq

Fighting continued in Mosul on Sunday. Iraqi troops entered the Old City, where the battle is expected to be the most difficult due to the geography of the neighborhoods. However, Major General Maan al-Saadi believes that the Islamic State militants have lost their resolve and the city could fall quickly now. About a third of the western half of the city — 17 of 40 districts — has been captured so far. It took 100 days to capture the eastern half. A new mass grave believed to contain the remains of victims of the Camp Speicher massacre has been discovered.

# Iraq Museum loans retrieved artefacts for the first time for the Iraq Pavilion at Venice Biennale

The Ruya Foundation announced further details for the National Pavilion of Iraq at the 57th Venice Biennale in May 2017. The exhibition, 'Archaic', will show the work of eight Modern and contemporary Iraqi artists in dialogue with 40 ancient Iraqi artefacts drawn from the Iraq Museum



and spanning six millennia, from the Neolithic Age to the Neo-Babylonian Period. Most of these objects have never left Iraq, excluding a few that were recently recovered after the 2003 lootings of the Museum. The exhibition will also be accompanied by a new commission by internationally acclaimed Belgian-born artist Francis Alÿs on the subject of war and the artist. 'Archaic' will be the third occasion on which the Ruya Foundation has commissioned the National Pavilion of Iraq at Venice.

#### Mass Grave of Shi'ite Inmates Killed by ISIS Found in Iraq

The remains of hundreds of mainly Shi'ite inmates killed by Islamic State militants (ISIS) when they overran a prison in northern Iraq more than two years ago have been unearthed by forces retaking the area from the group, a spokesman said. An Iraqi Shi'ite paramilitary group made the discovery after driving the militants from the Badush area where the prison is located, as part of a wider U.S.-backed campaign to dislodge ISIS from the city of Mosul.

#### Iraq watches for chemical weapons

Iraqi UN Ambassador Mohamed Ali Alhakim said on Friday there was "no evidence" that Islamic State had used chemical weapons in Mosul, where the militants are fighting off an offensive by US-backed Iraqi forces. Mr Alhakim said he spoke with officials in Baghdad at midday on Friday and "there was really no evidence that Daesh has used this chemical weapon." Daesh is another name for Islamic State. The United Nations said last Saturday that 12 people, including women and children, had been treated for possible exposure to chemical weapons agents in Mosul since March 1.

# Iraq unsure if UN help needed to probe Daesh crimes

Iraq is assessing what help it might need to collect and preserve evidence of Daesh crimes, but has not yet decided whether it needs United Nations assistance, the country's UN Ambassador, Mohamed Ali Alhakim, said on Friday. Britain is drafting a UN Security Council resolution to establish a UN investigation to collect and preserve evidence for future prosecution, but would like Iraq to approve such a move by sending a letter formally requesting council action.

#### Iraq's pro-government forces discover mass grave in Mosul

Iraqi paramilitary forces said Saturday that they had uncovered a mass grave with the bodies of hundreds of people who were executed by "Islamic State" (IS) militants at Badush prison near Mosul. It is the latest discovery in Iraq as the country's paramilitary forces continue to take back territory captured by IS three years ago. Iraqi forces have uncovered dozens of mass graves containing hundreds, if not thousands, of bodies, as they push back IS forces after more than two years of heavy fighting, including the current initiative to retake Mosul.

# Iran Refutes Media Allegations on Plans to Set Military Base in Syria
