At least 142 were killed and 34 were wounded or sickened in recent violence: In Mosul, snipers killed 64 civilians as they tried to escape across the Tigris River. An airstrike killed five militants, including a close aide to Islamic State leader Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi. Chemical weapons sickened 26 people in Dandan and Jawzq.

Terrorist Confesses to Working with White Helmets in Aleppo

In confessions broadcast by the Syrian TV on Saturday evening, al-Hendi said that he joined the "white Helmets" three years ago in return for receiving funds from the so-called "local council" and financers from Arab countries, SANA reported. Hendi said that they were told that there will be chemical attacks, and they were given protective clothing and they staged a fake chemical attack that was filmed by a Turkish channel, adding that they were filmed by two people called Ibrahim al-Haj and Mohammad al-Sayyed as they sounded sirens and brought stretchers to transport supposed injured people, with the intent of posting these videos online and accuse the Syrian Arab Army of carrying out a chemical attack.

The Syrian army aided by Iranian-backed militias is moving troops to a desert region near its border with Iraq and Jordan as US backed rebels are consolidating control in an area from which Islamic State militants have recently pulled out, rebel sources and commanders say. They say intelligence shows that hundreds of Syrian troops and Iranian-backed Shi'ite militias with tanks and heavy equipment have moved to the town of Sabaa Biyar, in a sparsely populated desert territory that goes all the way to the Jordanian and Iraqi border known as the Syrian Badia.

At least 1,500 Syrian rebels and their families abandoned another long-held district just outside of Damascus on Sunday, as the army of President Bashar al-Assad and its allies push to seize full control of the capital and surrounding areas for the first time in nearly five years. Iran's presidential candidates are making final preparations for Friday's landmark poll, which could have hugely significant implications for the country and the world beyond. At the centre of the contest are differing views over incumbent President Hassan Rouhani's signature accomplishment: The 2015 landmark nuclear accord and his wider advocacy of economic and political re-engagement with western powers.
